


Post-Conflict Military Roles in Colombia



- Combat remaining organized armed groups
- Support combat against **organized criminal groups**
- Support the National Police in fight against
 common crime, especially in rural areas
- Patrol coasts, rivers, and borders
- Manual eradication of illicit crops
- Participation in UN peacekeeping missions
- Operational de-mining
- Development projects, especially infrastructure
- Help during natural disasters
- Environmental protection, especially forests
